Emergency Medicine Physician Assistant Residency Program

Resident Selection and Eligibility

Resident Selection- The University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics ensures that programs select from among eligible applicants on the basis of their preparedness, ability, aptitude, academic credentials, communication skills, and personal qualities such as motivation and integrity. Programs must not discriminate with regard to sex, race, age, religion, color, national origin, disability, or veteran status. PA Program Faculty will consider the following when reviewing applications.

- 1. Transcripts/GPA
- 2. Letters of Recommendation
- 3. Healthcare Experience
- 4. Leadership Experience
- 5. Research/Scholarly Activity
- 6. Community Service
- 7. Contribution to Diversity, Equity and Inclusion

Resident Eligibility - Applicants with the following qualifications are eligible for appointment to the Emergency Medicine Physician Assistant Residency Program.

- 1. Graduates of an accredited Physician Assistant program in the United States
- 2. Licensed or eligible for licensure in lowa by the start of residency program
- 3. Evidence of excellent written and verbal communication skills
- 4. Demonstrated interest in Emergency Medicine
- 5. Demonstrated multi-tasking and conflict resolution skills
- 6. Effective in a team-based setting
- 7. Highly motivated learner
- 8. Previous experience in Emergency Medicine is considered, but not required
